# **Key Responsibilities**

- Maintain a safe learning environment including indoors and outdoors.
- Follow a full daily and weekly schedule of activities for children ages 2-5 years old.
- Use appropriate teaching materials and a variety of teaching strategies to promote learning.
- Create developmentally appropriate lessons that align with a student's physical, emotional, and intellectual needs.
- Regularly communicate with parents and update them on the progress of their child.
- Provide opportunities for children to explore God's creation and learn about His love for them through supplied teaching resources.
- Provide opportunities to participate in a variety of activities that encourage play and good health.
- Provide basic care and support for student's physical, emotional, and intellectual needs.
- Assess children's progress in reaching certain goals and objectives.
- Enforce clear rules and use a variety of positive behavior reinforcement strategies.
- Model professional and appropriate behavior to students and parents.
- Adhere to all policies and COMAR requirements for a child care center.
- Coach and lead Assistant Teachers or Aides in the classroom.
- Collaborate with other colleagues to ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all children.

## **Position Requirements**

- Enjoy outdoor activities in all types of weather.
- Must be 19 years of age or older.
- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent or courses for credit from an accredited college or university.
- Successfully completed 6 semester hours or 90 clock hours or equivalent approved preservice training.
- Completed 3 hours of approved training in complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- Completed 9 hours of preservice training in communicating with staff, parents, and the public or at least one academic college course for credit.
- Have minimum 1 year of experience working with preschoolers in a licensed child care center, nursery school, church-operated school, or similar setting, or as a registered family child care provider caring for preschoolers.
- Those with an associate's or higher degree in early childhood education meet the above requirements.
- Complete 12 hours of approved continued training per full year of employment.
  - o Minimum of 6 hours in core knowledge.
  - o Maximum 6 hours in elective training.

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
