Key Responsibilities

- Assist teachers with maintaining a safe learning environment including indoors and outdoors.
- Assist teachers with following a daily and weekly schedule of activities.
- Use appropriate teaching materials and a variety of teaching strategies to promote learning.
- Regularly communicate with parents and update them on the progress of their child.
- Assist with providing opportunities for children to explore God's creation and learn about His love for them through supplied teaching resources.
- Assist with providing opportunities to participate in a variety of activities that encourage play and good health.
- Assist with providing basic care and support for student's physical, emotional, and intellectual needs.
- Assist with enforcing clear rules by using a variety of positive behavior reinforcement strategies.
- Model professional and appropriate behavior to students and parents.
- Adhere to all policies and COMAR requirements for a child care center.
- Collaborate with other colleagues to ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all children

<u>Position Requirements</u>

- Enjoy outdoor activities in all types of weather.
- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- Complete approved basic health and safety training within 90 days of employment.
- Complete 6 hours of approved continued training per full year of employment.
 - o Minimum of 3 hours in core knowledge.
 - o Maximum 3 hours in elective training.
- Complete an orientation session within 6 months of hire that covers:
 - Proper child supervision
 - Workplace professionalism
 - Interacting with parents
- Individuals who have completed an equivalent training or completed their 90 hours are exempt from completing the orientation session.

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
