Key Responsibilities

- Along with Senior Counselors, the Bible Stories Teacher is to supervise the assigned campers while they are teaching the lesson.
- Teach the Bible lesson according to the materials, resources, and training provided to them and in a respectful, engaging, and joyful way.
- Make adjustments to the lessons to make it age appropriate for the different age groups of campers, while still holding to biblical truths.
- Communicate any needs such as being short of supplies, broken equipment, or facility repairs in an email to the Program Manager as soon as you become aware of the need.
- Adhere to all Beachmont Christian Camp policies, procedures, emergency action plans, and COMAR requirements for a summer day camp.
- Organize, label, and maintain all props and costumes that are used for Bible Stories and Forest Theatre
- Assist with leading the Forest Theatre time along with the Team Leader.
- Maintain cleanliness by wiping down props, sweeping the stage, and putting away all costumes and props.
- Manage camper behavior by enforcing clear rules and use a variety of positive behavior reinforcement strategies.
- Model Godly, professional, and appropriate behavior to campers and parents.
- Follow a full daily and weekly schedule of activities.
- Disciple campers in their walk with God.
- Perform other work-related duties as assigned.
- Attend all assigned meetings and devotions in a punctual manner.
- Supervise and engage guest teens on our Teen Nights (Tuesdays, 6:15PM 10:15PM).

<u>Position Requirements</u>

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Practicing follower of Christ who is passionate about growing in their faith.
- A passion for working with children.
- Significant skill with acting out skits.
- Significant skill in teaching.
- Ability to manage the needs of multiple campers, simultaneously.
- Ability to adhere to safety protocols, including all policies and procedures.
- Each staff member must complete a background check in order to be hired.

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
