Key Responsibilities

- Serve lunches and concessions to campers, junior counselors, and staff during the lunch periods.
- Serve snowballs and ice cream at the end of the camp day at the Concessions building.
- Adhere to all health regulations when handling, storing, and serving food.
- Stock all vending machines and restock concessions during and at the end of the lunch period.
- Take inventory for all perishable and non-perishable items and send data to the Operations Manager.
- Receive food deliveries and transport to lunch serving area.
- Maintain cleanliness by wiping down all surfaces, cleaning all food serving supplies, sweeping and mopping floors, and putting away all equipment.
- Adhere to all Beachmont Christian Camp policies, procedures, emergency action plans, and COMAR requirements for a summer day camp.
- Responsibly use and operate Beachmont equipment after receiving proper training.
- Model Godly, professional, and appropriate behavior to campers, parents, and staff.
- Follow a full daily and weekly schedule of responsibilities.
- Disciple Junior Counselors and campers in their walk with God.
- Perform all work-related duties as assigned in a timely and efficient manner.
- Attend all assigned meetings and devotions in a punctual manner.
- Supervise and engage guest teens on our Teen Nights (Tuesdays, 6:15PM 10:15PM).

- Practicing follower of Christ who is passionate about growing in their faith.

- A heart for serving others and a passion for completing tasks.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks.
