Key Responsibilities

- Follow all of Beachmont's medical protocols and procedures in the Medical Book
- Attend to and care for all medical needs and emergencies during day camp hours
- Lead the nurse interns in all responsibilities and duties during camp hours.
- Keep a clean and tidy nurse's office and area
- Ensure there are sufficient supplies by taking inventory daily and checking expiration dates on medications
- Ensure all staff, junior counselor and camper medical paperwork is completed correctly and turned in
- Fill out the Health Record Log, Nurse Notes and other documentation as needed every time a patient is seen
- Ensure that all medications are given at proper times
- Ensure that all medications are returned to the proper owners on the last day of each session and fill out the accompanying disposition form
- Communicate with parent's/legal guardian's as needed in a calm professional manner.
- Communicate with the Program Manager and Operations Manager during emergencies and as needed
- Respond to walkie talkie communications in a timely manner
- Be a positive member of a team who seeks to serve others and resolve any conflicts in a biblical manner.
- Model Godly, professional, and appropriate behavior to campers, parents, and staff.
- Disciple Junior Counselors and campers in their walk with God.
- Attend all assigned meetings and devotions in a punctual manner.

Position Requirements

- At least 3 years of nursing experience working with children.
- Practicing follower of Christ who is passionate about growing in their faith.
- A passion for working with children.
- Utilize a deep understanding of medical safety and best practices.
- Utilize a strong set of technical skills to effectively carry out assigned tasks.
- Ability to manage the needs of multiple people, simultaneously.
- Ability to adhere to safety protocols, including all policies and procedures.
- Exceptional organizational skills.
- High level of attention to detail.
- Highly relational and personable.
