Key Responsibilities

- Assist Senior Counselor with supervision of the assigned campers at all times.

- Assist with managing camper behavior by enforcing clear rules and use a variety of positive behavior reinforcement strategies as directed by the Senior Counselor.
- Model Godly, professional, and appropriate behavior to campers, parents, fellow JCs, and staff.
- Follow a full daily and weekly schedule of activities.
- Assist with discipling campers in their walk with God.
- Regularly communicate with their Senior Counselor about responsibilities and any issues.
- Assist with monitoring campers during meal time to ensure they are getting the proper nutrition.
- Assist with monitoring camper's hydration by taking regular water breaks.
- Perform other work-related duties as assigned.
- Attend all assigned meetings and devotions in a punctual manner.
